The builder took his time getting things set right. seller states the TH350 will drip fluid out the shifter prawl area. The power steering lines also drip when not in use. Plan to give it a couple hours of fine tuning / tlc before heading across the country with it. One nice thing about this truck is it has it's history written all over it. You can see it was a farm truck. Judging by the drivers door scratches, it went through a barbed wire fence at least once, etc.

This engine runs but it is running poorly. You will need to tinker with it before you will be able to cruise around.

Seller Says: Mustang II front end, 5 lug rotors, front wheels are 14") manual brakes - Power rack and pinion -'69 mustang small block radiator, used running SBC V8 engine, Summit Racing brand 4Bbl, dual plane, HEI, block hugger headers -TH350, B&M ratchet shifter, GM tilt steering column, GM fuse block and harness , S10 Bench seat, Lap seat belts, Glass new, one very small crack near windshield divider. New window felts, runners -'57 Ford 9 inch rear end (3:08 ish gears??) with chrome backing plates -New water, oil, speedo gauges -Cab and doors VCG, easily fixable -Front fenders and running boards salvageable -The only appreciable rust on this pickup is in the box sides -Rear fenders typical of an old farm truck -Tailgate salvageable -1969 Mustang fuel tank mounted between rear frame rails
